Transitional Living

The Carolyn Williams Center (CWC) is a 24-month, transitional housing program for young men that have aged out of foster care or are street or couch homeless. This program provides skills and resources they need to achieve self-sufficiency.

Emergency Shelter

CWC also provides a 120-day emergency shelter, ensuring that young men in the community won't need to sleep on the streets while they find a home.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be without a home
- Males, ages 18-23
- Cannot have a conviction for a violent crime

Program Requirements:

- Have a strong commitment to making a change in their life
- Participate in life skills classes
- Complete household tasks
- Small program fees
- Minimal, refundable security deposit
- Random drug testing

Program Benefits:

- Housing/Shelter
- Personalized case management
- Goal planning
- Supportive services
- Career & education planning
- Transportation Assistance
